Addressing Challenges

- The client was leaving their existing MSP for performance issues while at the same time looking to consolidate providers, increase bandwidth & uptime, migrate infrastructure to AWS, and were implementing new systems at all retail locations to modernize the customer experience
- The existing store network was inconsistent between corporate and franchises, included multiple vendors & technologies, and there was very low confidence it would support the Project Evolution store of the future initiatives



Ensuring Success

- Opex's Client Success Team partnered with the client and the winning provider to create ordering and implementation workflow to ensure implementation timelines are met with corporate and franchise stores
- The result was a consistent store network design with increased bandwidth, redundancy and provider consolidation to support their Project Evolution future initiatives without increasing any costs

- Streamlined the RFP to POC to final contract execution and implementation kickoff process on time enabling them to move away from current provider before contract expired
